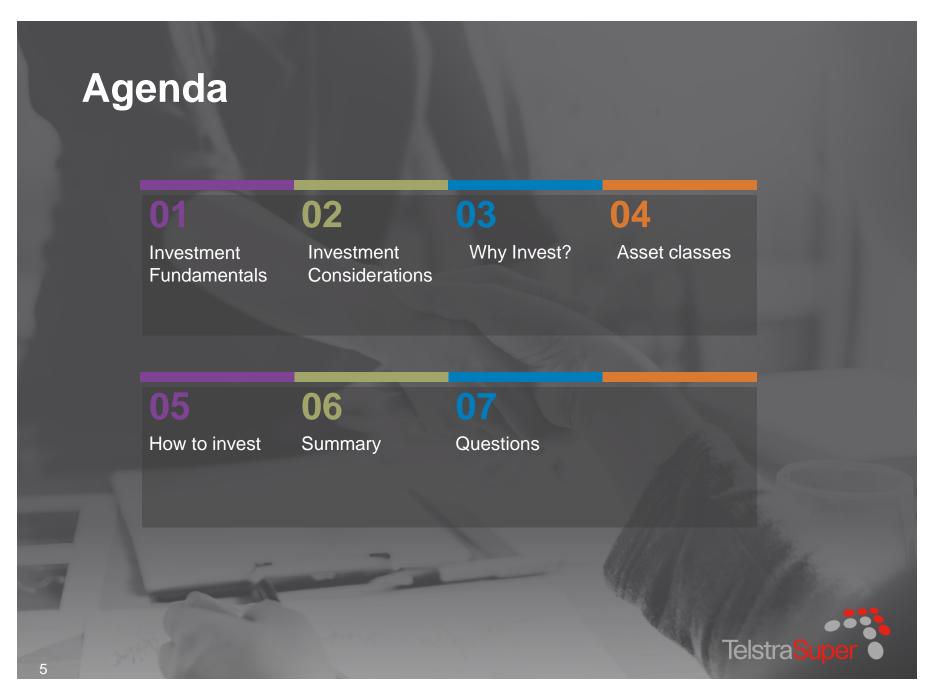

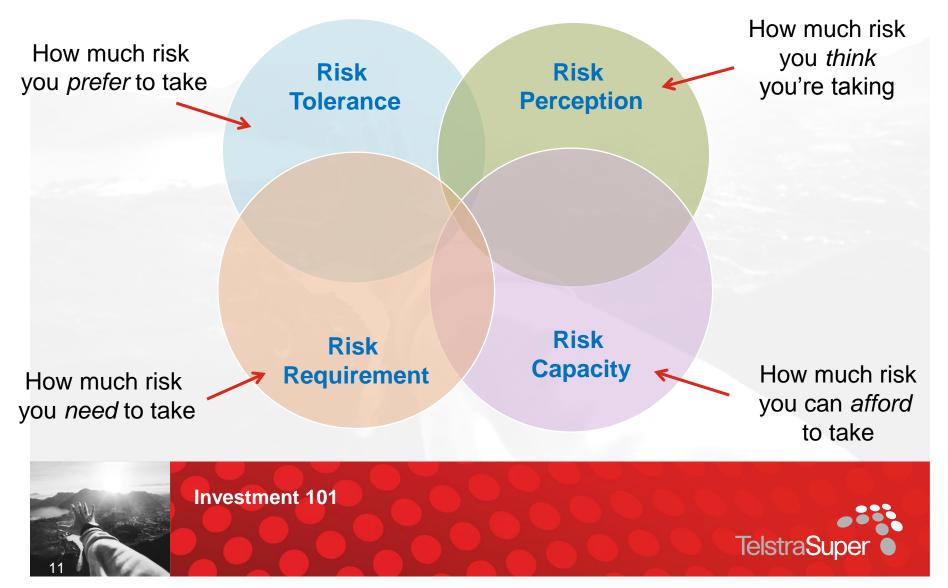

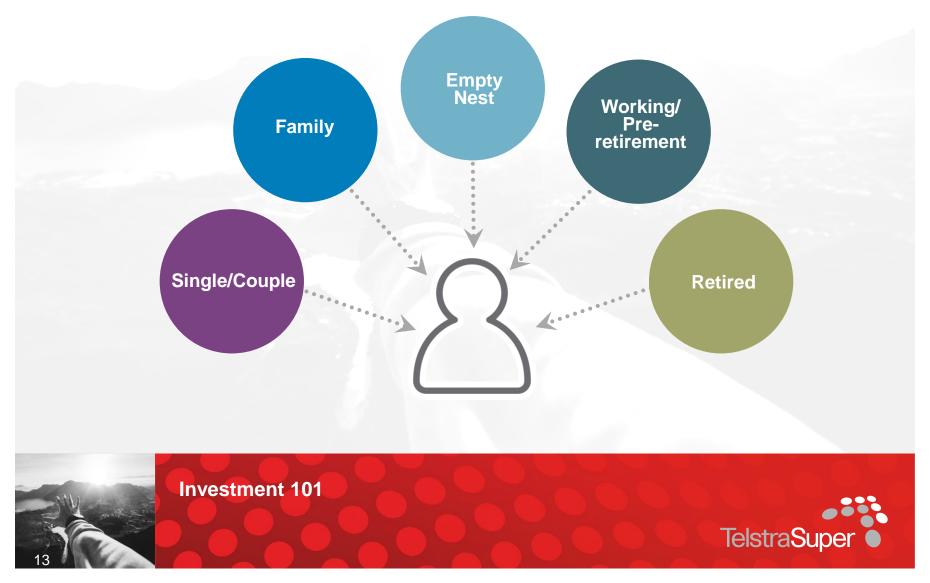

Stage of Life



Liquidity

High Liquidity

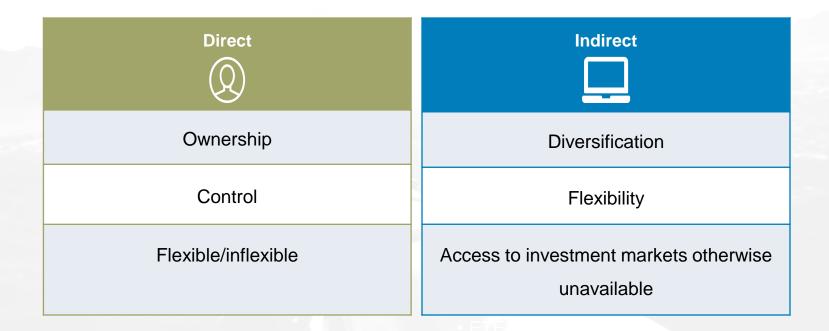
- Easy disposal
- High demand asset
- Easily acquired/transacted asset
- Regular valuations

Low Liquidity

- Long sale lead time/settlement and often requires 3rd party
- Infrequent valuations
- Lock up periods, redemption restrictions
- Low demand
